# + ePortfolio Defined\*

- “a collection of authentic and diverse evidence, *drawn from a larger archive*”
- representing what a person or organization has learned over time *on which the person or organization has reflected*,
- and designed for presentation to one or more audiences *for a particular rhetorical purpose”*

\* (NLII 2003 and FuturEd 2005)

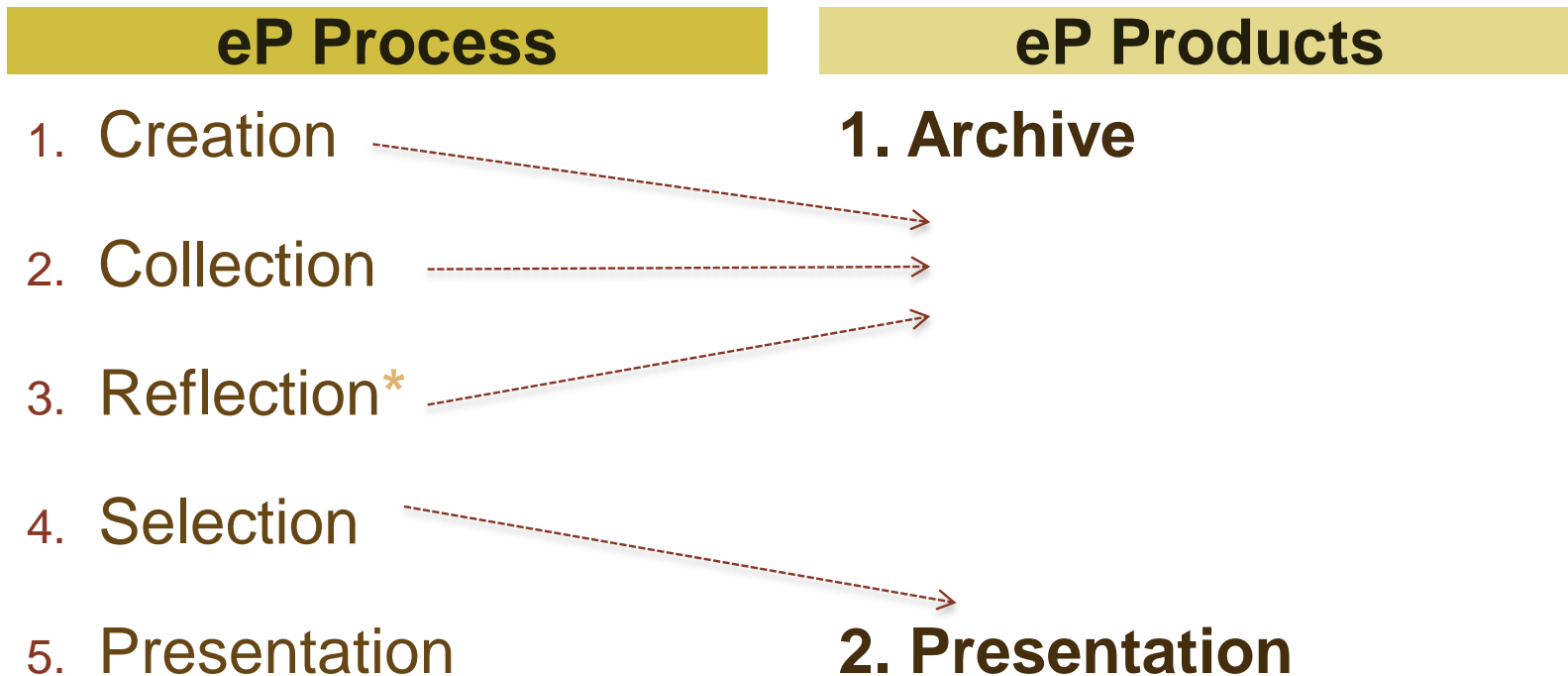


# Basic concepts

## ...Not just a digital CV

- “ePortfolio” is a System of
  - Digital creation/storage and presentation
    - Tools and services
  - Production and “consumption”
    - Creator and user = ROI
  - Process and product
    - Basically:  
*“Here’s what I know and can do,  
Here’s how/ where I learned it, and  
here’s the (digital) evidence!”*

# + Reflection practice (in teams)

You are preparing for a job interview. You will be asked:

1. What was your last job? What were your key tasks?
2. What did you excel at? How did you learn it? Do you have evidence? **THIS** takes reflection.
3. Can you produce digital evidence?

**Critical importance of your archive!**

**Same for students!**





# + What is traditional evidence of ability?

- Academic CV
- Professional resume
- Typically these capture your formal learning – your credentials and work experiences.

**BUT**

- *Does it capture all of your abilities?*
- *Does it adequately describe what you are able to do?*
  - *Is it always current?*
- *Can you provide evidence of your assertions?*

# + Better than a CV

Characteristic	Traditional Résumé	ePortfolio
content	lists of credentials and work experiences (with skills and knowledge implied)	lists of skills and knowledge (with learning experiences and credentials referenced where appropriate)
development process	keep track of formal credentials, dates, employer addresses, job descriptions	examine learning experiences for the skills and knowledge acquired
perspective on learning	learning happens largely in formal institutions, and credentials and work experience are the valued learning opportunities	learning happens in both formal and non-formal situations, and all learning has value
format	short and factual	may be more comprehensive, with broader lists that can be cross-referenced with actual skills and knowledge in job and training requirements
validation	credentials and employer's references have been unchallenged proxies for learning	different forms of validation are required, in addition to credentials and references, e.g., personal references
purpose	to get a job	for career planning and development: appropriate work and/or training

# Critical Quality Principles

*(Consumer's Guide to ePortfolio Tools and Service)*

## An ePortfolio MUST:

- Be owned by individual / creator
- Be secure, with access controlled
- Incorporate all forms of learning
- Be transportable
- Demonstrate ROI

**Others also create digital information about you.  
Combined with what you create =  
your Digital Identity.**

+ **Evidence: deliberate/accidental**  
**(Google your name?)**

  - Easy access (by you)
  - Controlled access (by others)
- Media to create evidence
  - Papers (scanning)
  - Presentations (video)
  - References (hyperlinks to)
  - References (audio by)

## 2. Presentation tools:

- Power Point Presentation
- Personal website
- Google sites / docs / blogs
- Microsoft SharePoint / groove
- Localized bespoke tools
- Social networking software
- Commercial tools
- Open source tools

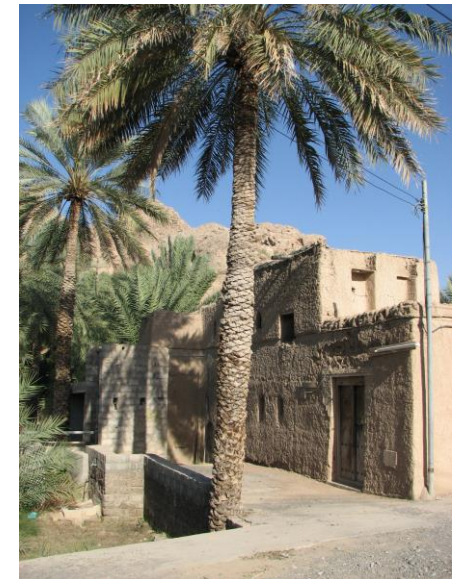
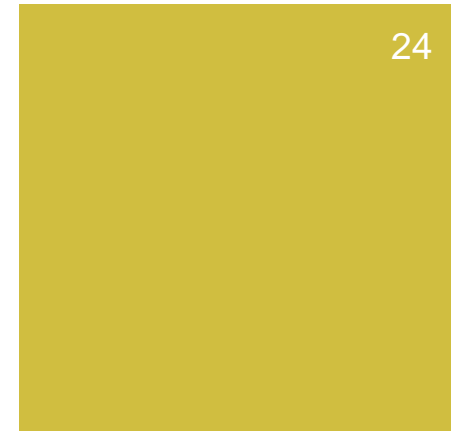
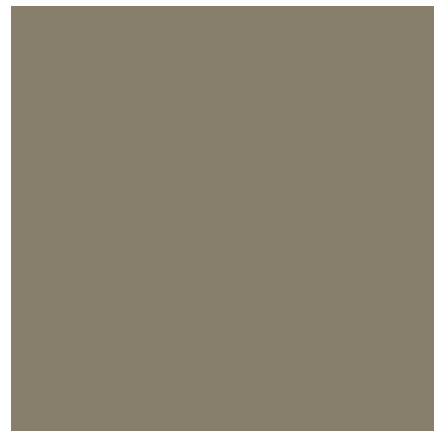

# Using your ePortfolio

## Slide #7: how I will use my eP

### Personal

- To archive evidence of achievements and KSAs
- To document change and development
- To target deficits for future training
- To value transferable skills
- To develop new ICT skills
- To model eP for students

### Shared

- To show evidence of achievements and KSAs
- To plan career development or change
  - To apply for tenure and promotion
- To apply for new positions
- To teach ICT and eP skills
  - To promote eP learning



# Benefits of professional ePortfolios in education

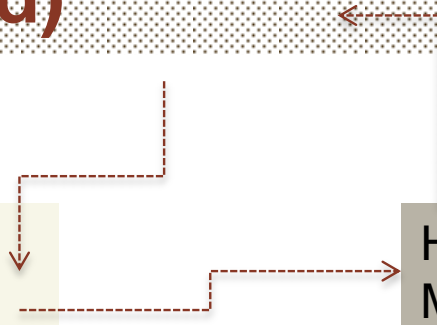
1. **Staff: personal development and management**

  - Tools and practical applications
  
3. **Institution: management function**
  - Quality assurance and performance appraisal
  - Lifelong learning and human capital management
  - Technologies present and future

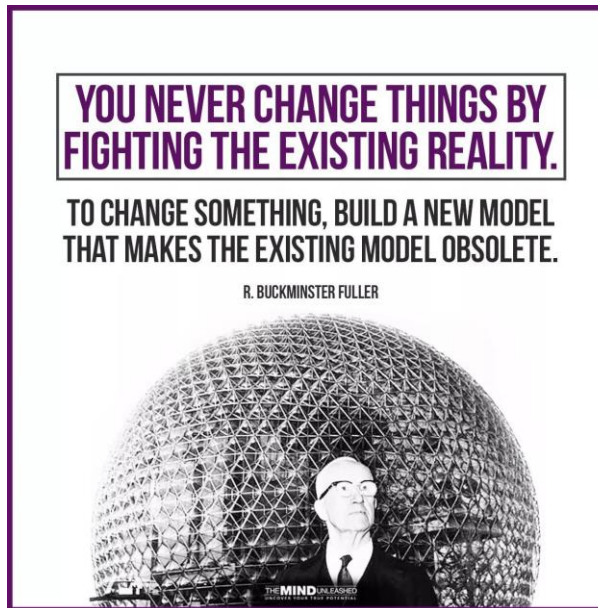

# + Human Capital D & M – replacing HR and credentials

  - Competencies (professional standards, lifelong learning)
  - Social capital (networks and communities)



- Management
  - Individual knowledge / learning as an asset
  - Collective knowledge for a business or nation

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# + Implications of ePortfolio for Human Capital Development

- **Individuals**
  - Develop and maintain ePortfolio
  - Take control of career
  - Develop efficient learning plans
  - Develop and maintain Digital Identity
  
- **Employers**
  - Complete inventory of workforce skills
  - More efficient description of work required
  - Pay for skills used not for time spent
  - Manage and target learning
  
- **Society at large**
  - Systematic Human Capital Accounting
  - Accurate inventory and skills gap analysis
  - Promotion of lifelong learning

# + Review...ePortfolio...

- A term used to encompass (1) tools, products and systems that can be used by (2) individuals, educators, employers and entire nations for the purposes of (3) describing, assessing, recognizing and using knowledge and skills (4) acquired through all forms of learning (5) with evidence that is digitally created, stored and managed through (6) practices that meet quality standards to assure transportability, usability, and security (FuturEd 2007)
